- Online holiday shop December 1st-4th
 - I spoke with an Anthony Lombardi about doing an online holiday shop this year for the kiddos to do their shopping. He said he will be emailing us with the site information so I can not give you an idea of the prices that will be offered. We have two options to chose from...
 1. Bulk ordering where we get 20% of sales but will have to sort the orders and deliver.
 2. Direct shipping where we get 10% of sales but items being order will be shipped directly to the home.
- We are also looking to link it to the app MemberHub. I did Ask Anthony if he had any experience with MemberHub and he said he would look into it and get back us..
 - Our breakfast with frosty will look a little different this year due to the Covid pandemic.
 - It will be held on December 5th from 9am to approximately 11AM. Weather permitting and if weather is not permitting we have requested a rain date of December 12th.
 - It will be held outdoors in an L shape from the gymnasium door. There will be temp checks and masks will be required. Mr. Crespo is looking into having a police officer present to help with traffic flow.
 - One family at a time will be escorted through the winter wonderland. As one family finishes their picture with frosty the next family will then be directed to the raffle basket entry to ensure the CDC standard of at least 6 feet distancing.
 - We will have the raffle baskets along the wall of the gymnasium door with volunteer to give you tickets to put in for your baskets of choice.
