N.J.A.C. 6A: 14-1.2 District eligibility for assistance under IDEA Part B item 18 (h)

Each district board of education shall ensure that a special education parent advisory group is established within the district to provide input on issues concerning students with disabilities.

What is SEPAG?

SEPAG is a volunteer group, and its effectiveness within the school is dependent on the participation of parents attending meetings, discussing special education topics, and learning about special education.

Who can become a SEPAG member?

Parents/guardians of students with disabilities and Individual Education Programs (IEPs).

The mission of the Beverly City School District SEPAG is to provide support and guidance for families of children with special needs.

The Beverly City School District SEPAG acts as a liaison on behalf of parents, providing information about the district's programs and serving as a resource to parents by communicating information about the special education process and our programs.
